

Since the given treadling had repeated lifts of the same tie up, I reorganized the tie up to direct tie plus 3-4. The resulting treadling is what's called a "walking treadling" and is how it would have been woven before the machine age.

In the draw down, I have first given the pattern I wove for the sample. The tie up shows the original tie up from handweaving.net on the left and my modified tie up on the right. The remainder of the draw down shows some treadling variations. The samples in the notebook include a washed sample and an unwashed sample.
