Echo Weave

These samples were woven both for the Foothills Guild who chose parallel threading for the year's study and the PPWG newsletter (I believe in the two birds with one stone theory). Also, I have been wanting to use this space dyed cone of tencel that I've been staring at for years.

The warp is a dark grey 10/2 tencel threaded 24 epi. The weft is an 8/2 tencel. I plan to sett the remaining warp at 30 epi in hopes that the pattern will be easier to discern.

I hand washed the fabric in warm water with a dash of Dove. Shrinkage was roughly 1% in both directions.
